- improve camping skills;
- go canoeing;
- hike through Piedmont river swamp;
- learn about wildlife;
- go fishing and birding;
- learn how to cook over a campfire;
- and, relax in the outdoors with their family.

Each family will have a mentor to make sure everyone feels welcome and has a great time.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Any family interested in learning more about camping and enjoying a weekend in the outdoors is invited to apply. Although there are no age limits, we highly recommend that children be a minimum of five years old. This is a family event and children will be under the supervision of their parents.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

If you are selected, a non-refundable \$25 fee per family is required. Food, camping equipment, transportation and activities will be provided once at the campsite.

WHAT TO BRING?

Sleeping bag or sheets/blanket and any other personal items.

HOW TO APPLY?

Complete the application and submit to Adam Schiavone by March 1. Space is limited to seven camping families.
