2008 marked another successful year for the Georgia Hunters for the Hungry program collecting 29,883.5 pounds of venison contributed by Georgia hunters. Since 1993, Georgia hunters have helped feed more than 1.25 million hungry Georgians. With additional processor locations and the addition of the “Drop-Back-A-Pack” program, Georgia Hunters for the Hungry continues to provide a way for hunters to address hunger throughout Georgia and to help their fellow Georgians.
